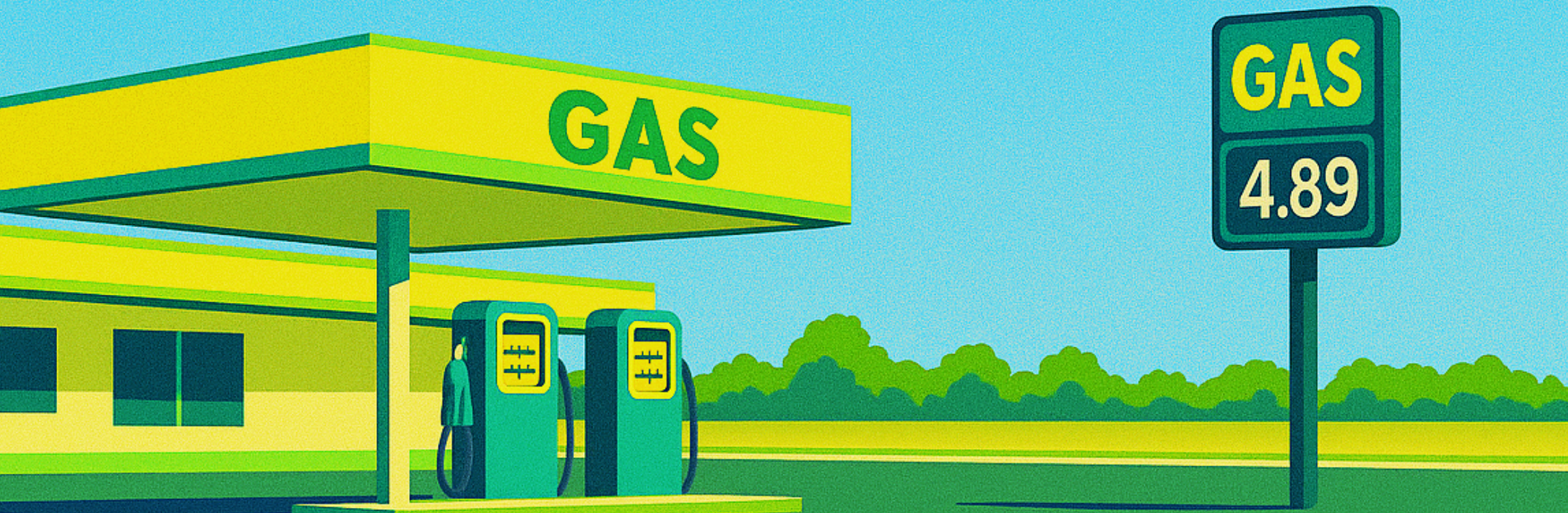


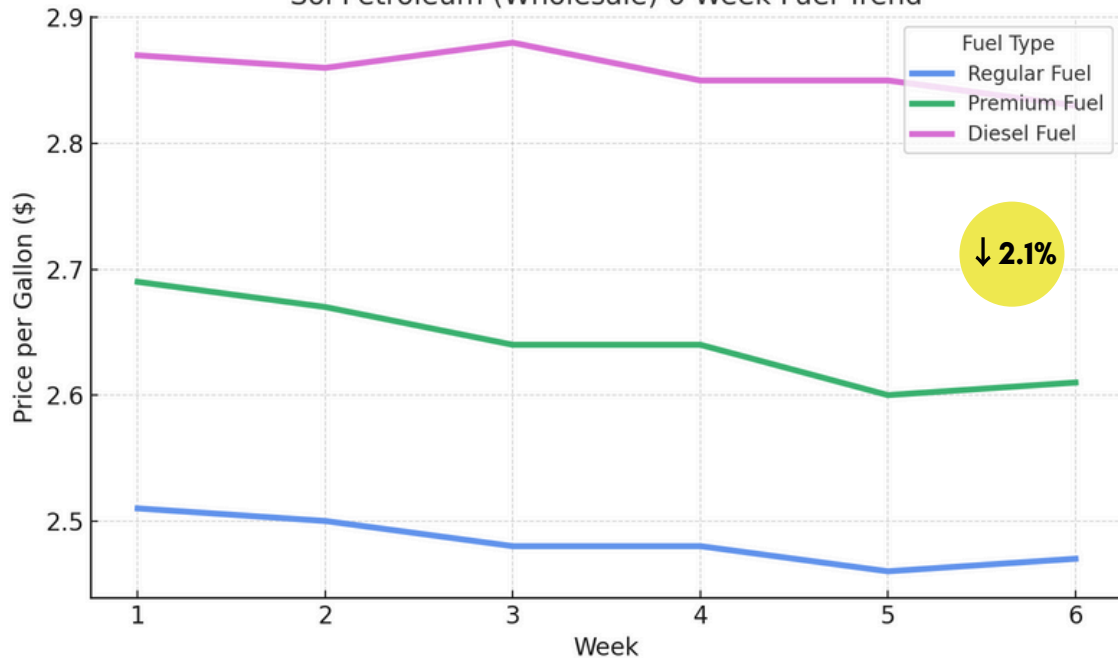

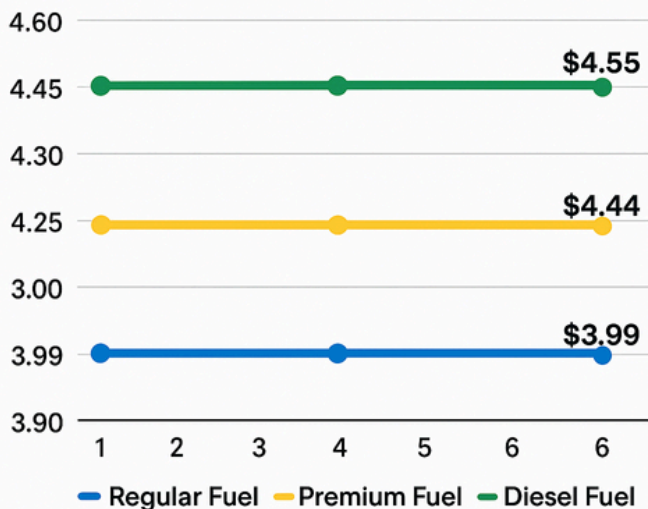
Sol Petroleum (Wholesale) 6 Week Fuel Trend



## 6-WEEK WHOLESALE TREND

- **Wholesale (Sol Petroleum):** Across all fuel types, Sol Petroleum wholesale prices declined by an average of 2.1% over the six-week review period.
  - Reg: ↓ from \$2.51 → \$2.47 (-1.6%)
  - Prem: ↓ from \$2.69 → \$2.60 (-3.3%)
  - Dies: ↓ from \$2.87 → \$2.83 (-1.4%)
- Wholesale pricing directly impacts retail rates on St. Croix.

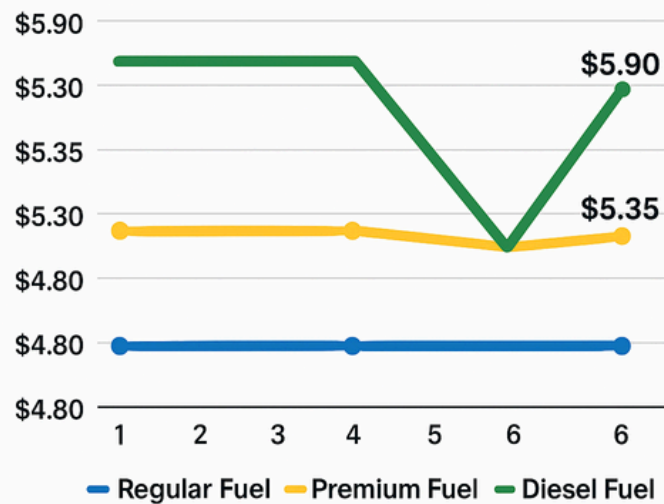
St. Croix 6-Week Retail Fuel Trend



### ST. CROIX RETAIL AVERAGES

Regular: Steady at \$3.99/gal  
 Premium: Steady at \$4.45/gal  
 Diesel: Steady at \$4.59/gal

St. Thomas 6-Week Retail Fuel Trend

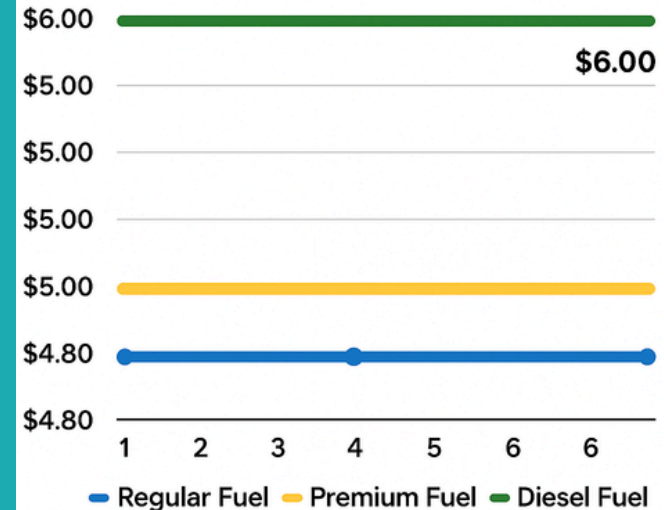


### ST. THOMAS RETAIL AVERAGES

Regular: Slight decrease from \$4.78 → \$4.77  
 Premium: Brief dip from \$5.35 → \$5.34 → \$5.35  
 Diesel: Mid-period fluctuation (\$5.89 → \$5.86 → \$5.89)

St. Thomas maintained the highest average retail prices in the territory, with negligible week-to-week variation.

### ST. JOHN RETAIL AVERAGES

Regular: Flat at \$4.79/gal  
 Premium: Flat at \$5.00/gal  
 Diesel: Flat at \$5.50/gal

St. John's retail fuel prices showed no movement across all categories, reflecting consistent retail pricing practices.
