**FORMAL COMPLAINTS REGARDING
HER MAJESTY'S CREDIT UNION CAN BE FILED
AT DLCA OFFICE**

The Department of Licensing and Consumer Affairs (DLCA) is notifying the public that persons who may have utilized the services of Her Majesty's Credit Union (HMCU) and have had difficulty gaining access to accounts and unable to make withdrawal of their deposits should contact DLCA to file a formal complaint. Individuals facing the unfortunate dilemma of not having access to their accounts can come to the Department and meet with a Consumer Protection Services (CPS) agent who will assist them in completing the required paperwork. Once the complaint has been documented, the CPS division at DLCA will continue its review and investigation of HMCU.

The Virgin Islands Department of Justice has commenced an investigation of Her Majesty's Credit Union and its affiliate companies and its principals, DLCA will continue to cooperate with the Department of Justice in the investigation of this matter.
